Project: Come join us in a great project from the Citrus organization and participate to the renovation of the future international host center in Laguëpie. For more than ten years, teenagers from around the globe have succeeded each other to build, renovate, conceive and shape a big project. In order to build an international host center for international volunteers in Citrus, come discover, learn and share building techniques in the spirit of working together. Since 2012, it is in the hamlet of the Mayounelle, on the hills above Laguëpie, that are located the three buildings of Citrus organization : the offices, the barn and the ancient farm house in stone, all surrounded by green fields, with a great view of the village of Laguëpie. Accompanied by dynamic facilitators, you will share working hours, but also many moments of intercultural exchange, as well as meals with the team and other volunteers, welcomed on the camp place.

Work: You will participate to the site layout by making your own contribution to Citrus, for instance the stone wall building and the creation of an artistic cobblestone. The cobblestone allows volunteers to be creative and use their imagination, by creating collectively a pattern, and to decide the size and precise location of the cobblestone. The stone wall building will allow to facilitate the identification of different areas of Citrus. Five mornings a week, you will work in teams. The schedule will be arranged depending on the weather.

Accommodation and food: Under tents on Citrus site, with an access to the sanitary block and a well-equipped kitchen. Your food will be prepared by the volunteers themselves. In this everyday life mission, you will be accompanied by the facilitators. Choices will be made to enhance a healthy balance depending on your preferences and local and seasonal production.

Location: On the international host site in Citrus organization, close to Laguëpie village, in Aveyron gorges, 100 km to the North-East of Toulouse, between Albi and Villefranche-de-Rouergue.

Leisure activities: In the heart of Aveyron gorges, you will enjoy the many possibilities that the Tarn-et-Garonne has to offer, either swimming in the Viaur river, the visit of the medieval villages among the most beautiful in France, such as Cordes-sur-Ciel or Najac. SJ/TRI31 A GARDEN FOR THE FUTURE

Group of 15 participants from France, Germany, Italy and Spain

Project: Our team of 15 people from all over the world live collectively on the domain of les Prureaux. We all carry out an ambitious project there: to renovate and maintain its main building: a centuries-old castle. Come join the adventure! Our environmental pole is made of a farm, a vegetable garden, an orchard and a garden. We experiment with the principles of permaculture, to make the area a harmonious, productive ecosystem, aiming for autonomy, naturally regenerated and respectful of nature and all its inhabitants.

Work: Like the whole site, the garden and the vegetable garden are constantly evolving. On the program this year:

1) Protect and delimit

The garden and the vegetable garden must be protected from external intrusions (fauna, flora, bad weather). You will build barriers and low walls to delimit the space using different materials: dry branches and roots, dry stones, small fruit trees. And according to ancestral techniques: plessing, braiding, piling, etc.

2) Enrich

You will participate in enriching the natural fertilizer via the "lasagna". These are alternating stacks of layers of matter, which have a "booster" effect on soil from technique: of organic the crops.

3) Develop

Le Créneau wishes to develop its natural spaces and integrate them into the daily life of its inhabitants: you will repair the garden hut, and make it a place of storage but also of gathering and discussion for school visits, by arranging a space in reused materials: pallets, etc.

4) Improve

You will help us optimize water management by maintaining our irrigation basin:

- Waterproofing
- Delimitation
- Layout

Accommodation and food: We get a camping area. For teenagers especially, the group will sleep in tents where girls and boys are separated. We have outdoor showers as well as dry toilets. Food will be prepared by the volunteers themselves in turns. You will create your own menus and "kitchen teams".
